About EU Reintegration Programme

The EU Reintegration Programme ensure the provision of reintegration assistance to returnees departing on a voluntary or non-voluntary basis from Member States and Schengen Associated Countries to their countries of origin. At the same time, it contributes to an effective return policy in the European Union, ensuring that returns are done in a dignified and humane manner. To implement this assistance, Frontex has concluded a partnership with IRARA who cooperates with *Charity Humanitarian Center Abkhazeti (CHCA) Georgia* to assure the deliverance of high level of support.



About CHCA Georgia

Established in 1995, CHCA is a Georgian, non-Governmental, non-profit organization, aiming to improve the livelihoods of conflict-affected and other socially vulnerable persons and enhance their social and economic integration. CHCA's goals are to increase the role of individuals and communities in building civil society and strengthening democracy, as well as to improve the social and economic conditions of internally displaced and other vulnerable populations through capacity-building and increasing self-reliance.
