IRARA Reintegration Programme for Migrants Returning to Somalia



Positive Futures

Arrival Reception and Reintegration Assistance

(i) Are you eligible for our support?

If you are a national of Somalia returning from Germany, you may be eligible to benefit from the programme if you have resided in Germany for at least 3 consecutive months.

(i) How can you apply?

You can apply to the programme at any Refugees return counseling center in Germany before you leave (or email: Reintegration@bamf.bund.de).

(i) Before your departure

If your application has been approved by the The Federal Office for Migration and Refugees you can request information from IRARA (www.irara.org) to help make the necessary arrangements.

(i) When you arrive

IRARA can provide you with basic assistance after your arrival in Somalia, including:

- Airport pick-up or reception at place of arrival
- In-country onward travel assistance
- Temporary accommodation (max 7 days)
- Referrals for urgent medical care
- Other basic essentials

() Signposting to local support services

We understand that you may have been away from Somalia for some time. All of our counsellors are nationals of Somalia that have expert knowledge of local community groups and networks that you may be able to benefit from.

(i) Reintegration package and services

As a returnee from Germany you may be eligible for a number of services provided through IRARA that support your reintegration. The reintegration services are delivered in-kind and the amount available will vary depending on a number of factors including your circumstances. We will work with you to develop a reintegration plan that takes into account your situation and needs. The services that we can provide include:

Technical and Vocational Training

• We can help to fund courses in vocational subjects so you can increase your skills and employability.

• Job Placement Assistance

• We can help you find appropriate jobs as well as support you through the application process.

• Business Start Up Assistance

• We can support you starting up your own income generating business – e.g. a taxi driving business.

• Education

• We can support you to find and fund the right education for your children - e.g. support with school fees.

• Referral to medical help

• The Reintegration allowance could help fund healthcare insurance for you and your family.

• Bespoke Assistance (for vulnerable groups)

 As an example, we can help support you in seeking specialist medical care The IRARA Reintegration Programme for Migrants Returning to Somalia is a project financed by the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees (Reintegration@bamf.bund.de) which supports voluntary returnees in their reintegration in Somalia.

This is done immediately after arrival in order to support the returnees in the first six months after arrival. The reintegration package includes advisory and support services, as well as support in the form of benefits in kind.
